Signs to Observe:

- General mood and changes in behavior
- Fever or elevated body temperature
- Skin rashes, unusual spots, swelling or bruises
- Complaints of pain and not feeling well
- Signs/symptoms of disease
 (severe coughing, sneezing, breathing
 difficulties, discharge from nose,
 ears or eyes, diarrhea, vomiting etc.)
- Reported illness in child or family members

Use all of your senses . . .

- · LOOK for signs
- · LISTEN for complaints
- FEEL for fever
- · SMELL for unusual odor
